


Garden reflects a landscape wetland connection of Wadjuk meaningful trails from Lake Galup (Lake Monger) to the river.

The native hibiscus pictured above is a recognised flower of healing and reconciliation. The native dianella is an important cultural element of food.

The current street trees selections are unsuitable (Plane trees, refer to text) for this location and for future

We request that these be removed during construction and be replaced with double the amount of trees. We suggest using the Paperbark trees used in the street adjacent the area.

Refer to proposed Landscape Plan for replacement numbers and the existing street tree elevations for study and justification of existing tree removal.



VERGE TREE PROPOSAL

EXISTING VERGE + SITE PERIPHERY TREES

The existing landscape character of the site is divided into the four roads that the campus interfaces, with a variety of species at each interface.

The Subiaco interface with Salvado Road is predominately by Jacarandas, providing amenity and is a key species for street and urban identity. Some Melaleuca and Eucalyptus strands towards the intersection with Haydn Bunton Drive are planted where it interfaces with the railway corridor to the south east, planted with other Australian natives.

The interface with Cambridge street is mainly characterised by Melaleuca species and London Plane Trees, with strands of Callistemons, Eucalyptus and Tipuanas. Species have been chosen for their resilience against harsh conditions although the plane trees have been heavily pollarded to limit size when overhead power lines were present.

The western interface with Station Street have significant Ficus trees and Agonis, melaleuca and Callistemon hedging that have overgrown, resulting in an unkempt but secluded grove although street planting along is sparse with existing Brachychiton species are showing sign of stress. Verges have been neglected with unkempt grasses and sandy

The eastern interface with McCourt Street contains a variety of species with recent plantings of Jacarandas.

PROPOSAL FOR REMEDIATION

Cambridge St is heavily populated with Plane And Paperbark Trees. For the SJOG development, we believe that the selection of Plane trees are unsuitable for this location and for future aspiration. Their caopies are too large for buildings, are hyper-allergenic when in blossom and their trunk at base is not suitable for hardscape urban contexts. The immediate area at SJOG are planted with paperbarks, with Plane trees being situated more to the eaast.

We request that these be removed during construction and be replaced with double the amount of trees. We suggest using the Paperbark trees used in the street adjacent the area. Please Refer to proposed Landscape Plan for replacement numbers and the existing street tree elevations for consideration.




